



About 4.5% of U.S. households, or 5.9 million households, did not have a checking or savings account with a bank or credit union in 2021, a record high score, according to a recent study by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. Households without and unmaintained bank accounts. Last year, unsecured banks made up 14% of US households, or 18.7 million people. Why do people have little or no access to banking services? Many of those without access to banking services report that they cannot afford to open an account due to insufficient funding and overdraft fees charged when the account balance is insufficient. Some 29% cited fees or a lack of required minimum balance as the top reasons for not having a checking or savings account, compared to 38% who cited these barriers in 2019. Unused banks were higher in working-age and disabled households with low incomes, including single mothers, blacks, or Hispanics. For example, among white households, 2% were unbanked last year, compared with 11% and 9% of black and Hispanic households, respectively. Meanwhile, almost 15% of households with able-bodied persons with disabilities were unbanked. compared to almost 4% of other households. AWS currently offers over 200 services. Have you already reached your peak or can you maintain this growth? We're not finished building yet, and I don't know when that will be. We continue to offer new services because customers need them and ask us for them, while at the same time we make great efforts to add new features to the existing services and move on. Within each of our services - you can choose any example - we are constantly adding new features. One of our main goals right now is to make sure we really help customers connect and integrate our different services. As such, features like building new services, and extend areas that we will continue to invest in. Do customers still need these building blocks and assemble them themselves, or do they just want AWS to handle everything? There is no one-size-fits-all solution for all customer needs. We definitely have customers who really want to get their hands behind the wheel and work with our services at the deepest level, at the most primitive level - so EC2 for computing, S3 for storage, or more of our database services and want to interact directly with those services. It's interesting, and I say a little surprising, how important basic skills like computing power are. to our customers. If you had asked me 15 years ago, "Hey, 2022 would be the peak of innovation in terms of raw computing power or pricing power in terms of what you think," I wouldn't have answered. sure guess it's still as important as it is. But it's absolutely important. This is partly due to the size of the data sets and machine learning functions, but nobody will be able to do it unless we keep improving the price significantly. We (also) have more and more customers who want to interact with AWS at a higher level of abstraction - more at the application level or in broader solutions. One of the largest of these is Amazon Connect, our contact center solution. You can have a cloud contact center up and running in minutes, hours, or days. At the start of the pandemic, Barclays sent all of its agents home. In about 10 days, they got 6,000 agents up and running on Amazon Connect so they could continue to provide customers. We have developed many sophisticated features in Connect based on machine learning. We can transcribe calls so managers can help train agents and services to derive meaning and issues from these calls. We're not talking about the primitive abilities that make this possible, we're just talking about the abilities to rewrite calls and extract meaning from calls. It's really important that we offer solutions to customers at all levelschallenges facing customers, how AWS provides businesses with a better ROI on their cloud investments? It's time to rely on the cloud more than ever, precisely because of uncertainty. We saw it during the pandemic in early 2020 and we see it now, which means that the benefits of the cloud only increase in times of uncertainty. In these uncertain economic times, we see that many customers are really leaning towards moving to the cloud.customers want to cut costs, and Amazon's chief financial officer said customers want to save money compared to what they spend. Do you still conclude long-term contracts and do clients have a chance to renegotiate at such moments? Last quarter we hit \$82 billion and had a 27% year-over-year increase, so of course we have every use case and customer for every situation imaginable. Many are rapidly accelerating their journey to the cloud. Some customers wear seat belts. We see a lot of people focusing on optimizing their resources and discarding resources they don't use. By the way, they should do this all the time. In the current economic climate, the motivation is only slightly higher. You see that some voluntary projects were not canceled but rejected. Our scale is large enough that we obviously have good economics when purchasing things like bandwidth, power and so on. We have built many industrial services for industrial service have a lot of capabilities that we're building that are either for horizontal applications like (Amazon Connect) or for specific industries like automotive, healthcare, financial services. We are seeing a growing demand for these elements and Dilip has stepped in to really bring together the capabilities of many teams to focus on these (areas). You can expect us to investin these areas and come up with some really exciting innovations. Would this mean moving to CRM, ERP or other higher level business applications? I don't think we have any immediate plans in those specific areas, but as we've always said, we're going to be completely customer-centric and go where our customers tell us is most important moving forward.
