The Triangle Between Othello, Iago, and Cassio

Being in this situation leaves Iago to be jealous of Cassio and very angry with Othello, and the question WHY? (But Iago never asks this question)

Othello is a very strong will and minded character but also very naive in believing everything that Iago tells him.

His other weakness is the love he has for his wife Desdemona. Othello being head of an army, I would assume would not be so gullible to believe everything he hears.
