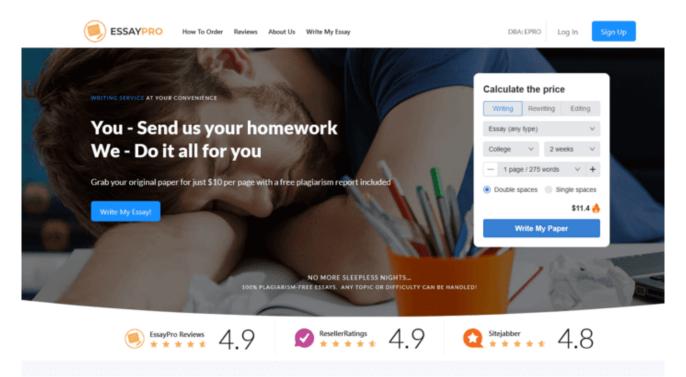
Self-discovery in Barbara Kingsolver's Animal Dreams
